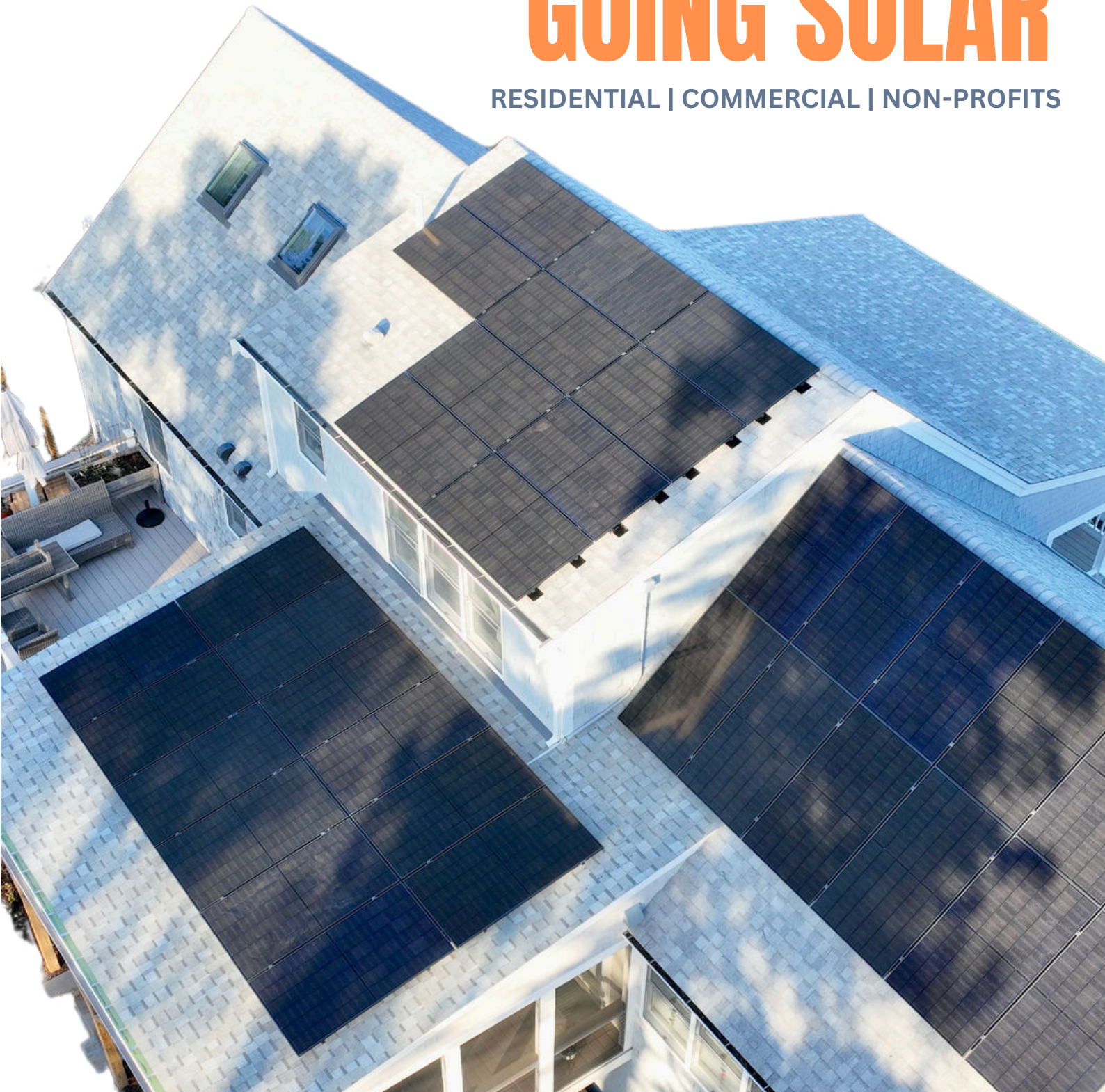

- Renewable Energy Certificates (RECs)
- Exempt From Local and State Property Tax for 20 years.
